### History

The Jonagold apple is a cross between Golden Delicious and Jonathan apples and was created in 1953 in Geneva, New York.

### Fun Fact

This apple variety could look like what you see to the right...but it could also be fully green or fully red with no yellow at all!



# Growing and Harvest



- Jonagold trees will be either semi-dwarf or dwarf varieties. Semi-dwarf Jonagolds grow to 12-15 feet tall and wide. The dwarf variety only reaches 8-10 feet tall and wide
- This variety has a shorter growing season than a lot of other apples which means they're coveted in September-December!
